

INDIANA SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED

Definitions Applicable to ISBVI Policies

Policy A-02

This policy defines two terms commonly used throughout the policies and handbooks of the Indiana School for the Blind and Visually Impaired (ISBVI). As used in ISBVI policies and handbooks, the terms defined herein shall have the meaning stated in this policy, unless the use of the word in the context of the policy clearly indicates a more limited meaning.

1. “Campus” shall mean all real property owned, leased, or rented by, or otherwise under the control of, ISBVI, including the properties listed below:
 - a. 2701 N. Devon Avenue, Indianapolis, Indiana 46219 (the “School Building”);
 - b. 1200 E. 42nd Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46205 (the “Residential Facilities” on the campus of the Indiana School for the Deaf); and
 - c. 5050 E. 42nd Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46226 (the “Administrative Office of the ISBVI”).
2. “Enrolled”, when used to refer to a student’s status, shall mean a student admitted to the residential and day school; however, as used in the following documents—ISBVI Policies O-02, O-26, and S-09, as well as the Health Center Handbook—it shall also refer to students admitted to day or overnight camps or short course programs (e.g., the braille challenge, LEADS courses).
