| | Return to school on day 6, if asymptomatic and fever-free for at least 24 hours. On day 6, if symptomatic, remain home until symptoms are improving and are fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication. Mask should be worn at school for days 6-10. |
| Isolation | If an individual, regardless of vaccination status, tests positive: |
| | Individual should isolate for 5 days per <u>CDC guidelines</u>. May return to school on Day 6, if asymptomatic or symptoms are resolving and are fever-free 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication. Should wear a mask at all times for days 6-10. |
| Student and Staff Exposure to COVID-19 | Individual, regardless of vaccination status, is exposed to |
| TO COAID-13 | someone with COVID-19, including home contacts: May remain at school as long as asymptomatic. Should wear a mask for the recommended 10 days. It is recommended to obtain COVID testing 5 days after exposure to someone with COVID-19. |
