

## Covid Protocol

It is the expectation of parents and guardians to only send healthy students to school each day. Please refer to the [Indiana Department of Education guidelines](#) for when a student is too sick to come to school.

COVID-19 Scenario	Actions to Take/Exposure
<p style="text-align: center;">Students and Staff Exhibiting COVID-19 Symptoms</p>	<p><b><u>Days 1-5:</u></b> Individuals must remain home for 5 calendar days following the onset of symptoms and a positive COVID test.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If asymptomatic, remain home 5 days after a positive test.</li> <li>• Please note that day one is calculated as the day symptoms started or if asymptomatic, the day after a positive test.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Days 6-10:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Return to school on day 6, if asymptomatic and fever-free for at least 24 hours.</li> <li>• On day 6, if symptomatic, remain home until symptoms are improving and are fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.</li> <li>• Mask should be worn at school for days 6-10.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;">Isolation</p>	<p>If an individual, regardless of vaccination status, tests positive:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individual should isolate for 5 days per <a href="#">CDC guidelines</a>.</li> <li>• May return to school on Day 6, if asymptomatic or symptoms are resolving and are fever-free 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.</li> <li>• Should wear a mask at all times for days 6-10.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;">Student and Staff Exposure to COVID-19</p>	<p>Individual, regardless of vaccination status, is exposed to someone with COVID-19, including home contacts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May remain at school as long as asymptomatic.</li> <li>• Should wear a mask for the recommended 10 days.</li> <li>• It is recommended to obtain COVID testing 5 days after exposure to someone with COVID-19.</li> </ul>
