PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS,

Indiana farmers are global leaders in productivity who successfully provide food and fuel for the world and drive our state's economy; and

WHEREAS,

Indiana is the seventh largest agricultural exporter in the nation, exporting over \$7 billion of agricultural goods each year; and

WHEREAS,

Indiana stands as a leader in agricultural production and exports in the United States, providing a vast array of products that are critical both domestically and internationally; and

WHEREAS,

Indiana's agricultural exports include but are not limited to corn, soybeans, pork, dairy, forest products and consumer-oriented food and beverage products; and

WHEREAS,

the enhancement of trade relations and the development of new trade agreements are vital for the continued growth and success of Indiana agricultural sector; and

WHEREAS,

it is imperative to raise awareness among consumers, businesses, and policymakers about the challenges and opportunities facing agricultural trade;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike Braun, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim March 19, 2025, as

Indiana Agriculture Trade Day
