



To qualify for a Hoosier Homestead Award, an active farm must currently be at least (20) acres, or if the active farm is less than twenty (20) acres, the active farm must gross at least \$1,000 a year. Once a qualifying farm family mails, e-mails or faxes this completed form and attaches the necessary documentation, the Hoosier Homestead program manager will review the application and documents. The family representative will then be contacted if more documentation is required or if they are approved or denied for the award. ISDA staff will only contact the family farm's application representative throughout the process.

The Indiana State Department of Agriculture does not solicit farms to apply for Hoosier Homestead honors.

The deadline for the March Ceremony is November 1, and the deadline for the August ceremony is April 1.

## **HOW TO APPLY:**

- 1. Complete the table on the second page beginning with the original family owner and continuing to present owner(s).
- 2. Provide documentation illustrating each transfer of ownership. The copy may be either of an original instrument, records maintained in a courthouse, or the page(s) from an abstract of title covering the real estate. The copies must demonstrate an unbroken familiar chain-of-title from the date that a member of your family originally acquired an interest in the real estate to the present.
- **3.** Provide documentation that the property taxes are paid up to date (this can be a either receipt from the county or a property tax bill showing there are no delinquent taxes)
- **4.** Return completed and signed application form and documentation to the Indiana State Department of Agriculture via mail, e-mail, or fax

## Please Note:

- If your family has received the Centennial or Sesquicentennial Award before and you are applying for the next award, you only need to supply ownership information for the property transfers that have occurred since the date the farm was last awarded a Hoosier Homestead Award to the present owner, and documentation that the property taxes are paid up to date.
- If less that twenty (20) acres of the original acquisition are retained, please provide documentation of the retained acres' s annual farm income.
