INDIANA GRAIN INDEMNITY BOARD OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Sheldon called this meeting of the Indiana Grain Indemnity Corporation Board of Directors to order at 10:05 a.m. (EDT) on July 18, 2016. The meeting was held in Assembly Halls C & D at Indiana Farm Bureau located at 225 S East St, Indianapolis, Indiana 46202.

QUORUM: Chairman Sheldon did a roll call of the Board members, stated that there was a quorum present.

MINUTES: Chairman Sheldon stated that the minutes from the May 31, 2016 meeting had been previously distributed to the board members and asked if there were any changes. **Mr. Whaley Motions, Mr. Silver Seconds to approve the minutes. Motion Carries.**

FINANCIAL: Vicki Pool read the financials as of June 30, 2016, see Appendix A. The fund contained \$24,557,982.15.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Chairman Sheldon gave a director's report, see Appendix B. Chairman Sheldon gave a brief update on Cline Grain, Inc., the Indemnity Fund collection, and software development for the Agency.

OLD BUSINESS: The meeting continued by rescinding the motion from May 31, 2016 that voted Curt Clifton was allowed to reenter the program. **Mr. Villwock motions, Mr. Silver seconds. Motion carries.** Curt Clifton had indicated that he did not intend to reenter the program. A motion was made to deny Curt Clifton's petition to reenter. **Mr. Whaley motions, Mr. Cherry seconds. Motion carries.** A motion was made to rescind Ron Brook's petition to reenter the program. **Mr. Villwock motions, Mr. Kessie seconds. Motion carries.** A

motion was made to deny Ron Brook's petition to reenter the program during the Cline Grain, Inc. failure. He can petition to reenter after the claims for Cline Grain, Inc. have been presented to the Board.

NEW BUSINESS: The letter notifying any producer who has been approved to reenter the program was presented to the Board. A motion was made to add more clarification as to what "coverage" means. **Mr. Whaley, Mr. Kessie seconds. Motion carries.** A motion was made to extend the premium collections another year due to the fund being below the \$25 million mark as of June 30, 2016. **Mr. Villwock motions, Mr. Kessie seconds. Motion carries.**

Chairman Sheldon gives an update on Cline Grain, Inc. All claims have been sent to the Administrative Law Judge. The Finding of Fact and Final Order (the Order) will come to the Agency for approval and then be distributed to all of the claimants and IGIC Board members. A motion was made to give the Agency Director authority to form a committee of one IGIC Board member and others from the industry to investigate the Cline Grain, Inc. situation. **Mr. Silver motions, Mr. Kessie seconds. Motion carries.** An IGIC Board meeting will be scheduled for early September 2016.

ADJOURNMENT: The Chairman adjourned the meeting around 12:00 p.m.

IGBWLA Director's Report

July 18, 2016

- Cline Grain
 - o Fact & Final Order nearly complete
 - Has involved detailed review of every claim by IGBWLA staff and Administrative Law Judge
 - Considerable staff time devoted to the issue (all IGBWLA staff, ISDA, LG, Attorney General's Office)
 - Projected final approval at September board meeting, depending on possible appeals
- Moisture Meters over 550 meters tested over past 2-3 months
- Audits with moisture meter season essentially complete, field staff is focusing on audits and schedules are full
- IGBWLA Resources
 - o Software Development
 - Level Up Development has been selected to develop new software for the licensing and auditing processes
 - Rapid Improvement Event (RIE) held June 6-10 to analyze the current auditing process and develop efficiencies
 - Licensing process under review to identify priorities and improvement opportunities
 - Phase 1 of software development will be for licensing, with the second phase being the development of new auditing software
 - Level Up staff participated in RIE and licensing process review to gain understanding of needs
- Indemnity Fund Collection
 - Collection is proceeding well with few significant issues
 - o IGIF compliance audits have generally been conducted during regular audits
 - o Auditors have assisted licensees in making corrections when needed
- Association of Grain Regulatory Officials (AGRO)
 - o National conference July 24-27 in St. Louis, MO
 - All IGBWLA staff will be in attendance
