RE: Final Adoption of the Amendment to Diagnostic Testing and Hyperbaric Oxygen Treatment Pilot Program Rule, 410 IAC 37-1-15, LSA# 19-575

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) requests that the Executive Board, at the Board's March 11th meeting, finally adopt the amendment to the administrative rule governing the Diagnostic Testing and Hyperbaric Oxygen Treatment Pilot (HBOT) Program, 410 IAC 37-1-15, LSA# 19-575.

The proposed amendments would extend program rules in accordance with IC 10-17-13.5-6. The current rule is set to expire on June 30, 2020. By statute, the HBOT Program is extended to June 30, 2021.

The Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule was published in the Indiana Register on November 3, 2019 starting the one year period to adopt this rule amendment. The Executive Board reviewed the proposed draft of this rule at the November 13, 2019 Executive Board meeting. ISDH has not made any changes to the rule based on public comment.
