

Injury-Related Outpatient/ Emergency Department (ED) Visits, Indiana, 2012

- There were 608,082 injury-related outpatient/ ED visits in Indiana in 2012, at an age-adjusted rate of 9,486.6 per 100,000.
- Males represent 51.0% of injury-related ED visitors, and men were 1.07 times more likely than females to be hospitalized due to injury (9802.1 versus 9116.4 per 100,000)
