RE: Final Adoption of Amendments to Electronic Reporting of Emergency Department Visit Abstract Data by Hospitals, Rule 410 IAC 1-2.4 (LSA Document #18-282)

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) requests the Executive Board, at the Board's January 9, 2019 meeting, finally adopt the rule that amends 410 IAC 1-2.4-6 to update the definition of Health Level 7; amends 410 IAC 1-2.4-8 to provide a requirement that hospitals provide notice of the system being offline if planned and to add additional data fields required to be reported by hospitals; and repeals 410 IAC 1-2.4-11.

The Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule was published in the Indiana Register on July 11, 2018, starting the one year period to adopt this rule. A draft version of the rule was presented to the Executive Board for its review on March 14, 2018. No changes have been made to the rule since the proposed rule was posted in the Indiana Register on October 17, 2018.
