RE: LSA Document # 20-XXX Inspection and Cleanup of Property Contaminated with
Chemicals used in the Illegal Manufacture of a Controlled Substance Rule

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) is presenting the Inspection and Cleanup of Property Contaminated in the Illegal Manufacture of a Controlled Substance Rule to Executive Board for discussion. The ISDH is proposing to repeal 410 IAC 38-1 through 6 and add 410 IAC 38-1.1, which consolidates and updates the rules regarding the clean-up and designation of property as contaminated by illegal drug manufacturing as well as the qualified inspector requirements. The proposed changes shall be effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.

This rule has not yet been submitted for moratorium review by ISDH.
