RE: Preliminary Adoption of Disease Reporting and Control Rule, 410 IAC 1-2.5 (LSA Document #15-39)

The Indiana State Department of Health requests that the Executive Board, at the Board's March 11, 2015 meeting, preliminarily adopt the proposed Disease Reporting and Control Rule at 410 IAC 1-2.5.

The proposed rule amendments will add 410 IAC 1-2.5 to add definitions, reporting requirements, dangerous communicable diseases, disease intervention measures, general and specific control measures, and documents incorporated by reference. It will add and modify control measures for schools, daycare facilities, preschools, health care facilities, and food handlers and will add reporting requirements for physicians, hospital administrators, and laboratories. The rule amendments will also repeal 410 IAC 1-2.3.

The Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule was published in the Indiana Register on February 11, 2015, starting the one year period to adopt this rule.
