Re: LSA Document #17-564 / Economic Impact Statement

Ms. Mackinnon,

Pursuant to Indiana Code 4-22, as the Small Business Ombudsman, I have reviewed the economic impact analysis for small business associated with the rule changes contained in LSA Document #17-564 proposed by the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH).

Based on my assessment as the Small Business Ombudsman, I have concluded that the proposed rule may put a burden on small businesses but seems to not be undue based on the assessment provided by the ISDH. This is a pilot program and is voluntary.

The economic impact statement prepared by the ISDH states, "There are no requirements or costs imposed on small businesses by the rule other than those set out in the statute."

Based upon this statement and review, the Small Business Ombudsman supports the proposed rule related to the economic impact to small business as not presenting an undue burden if the ISDH conclusion reflects the actual result after promulgation.
