**Suicides**

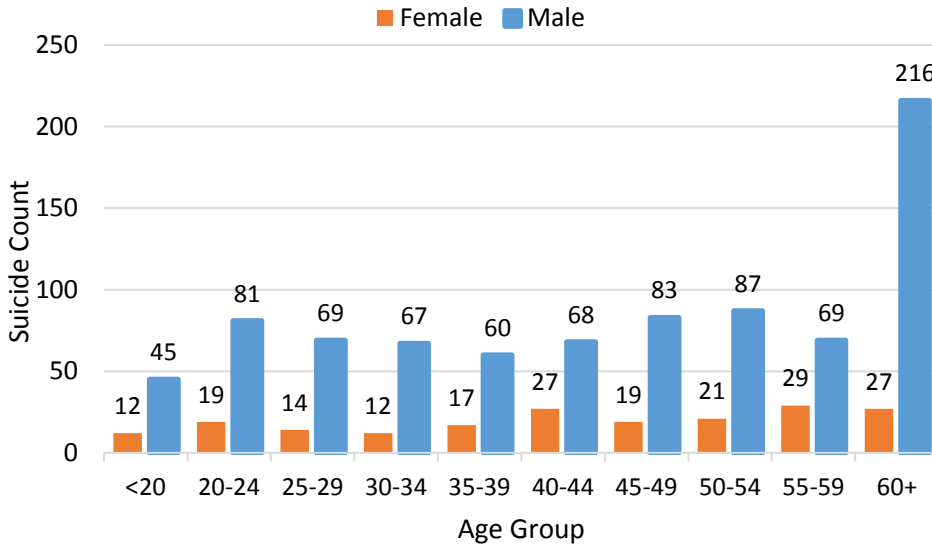
A total of **1,042** suicides occurred in Indiana in 2016. The data below is based off those deaths.

**15.7**

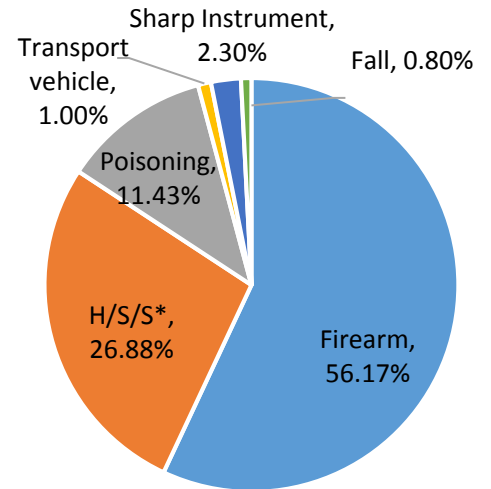

**Suicide Cause of Death**

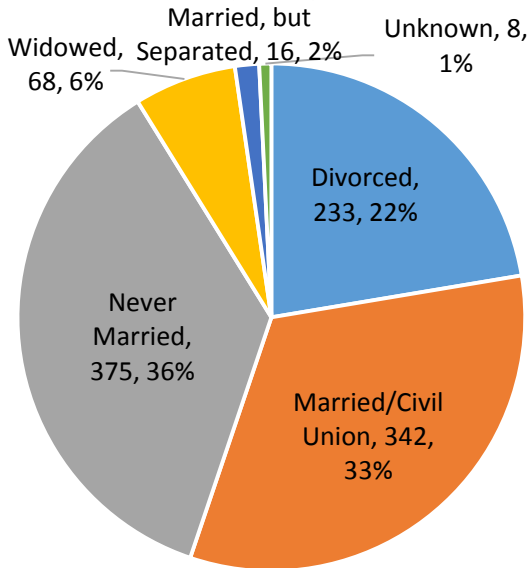

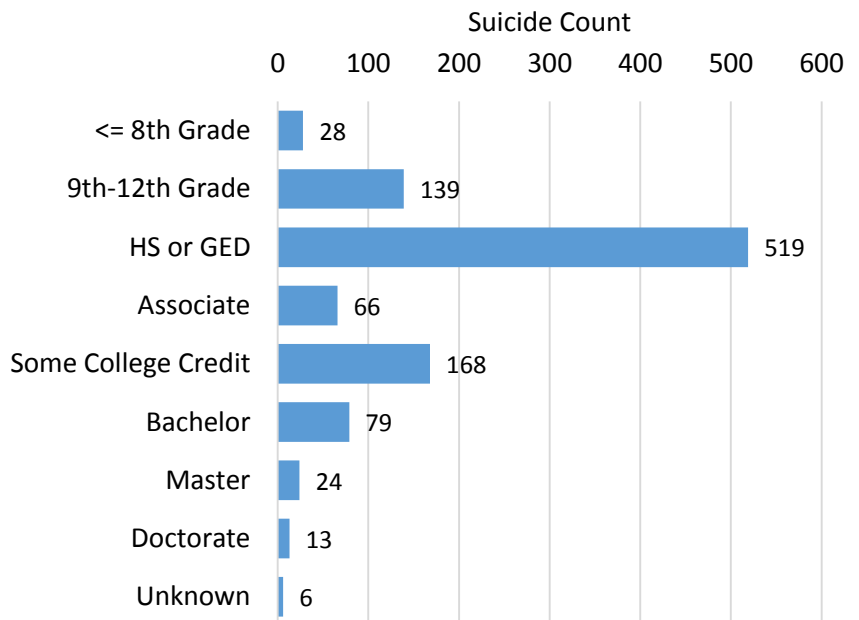

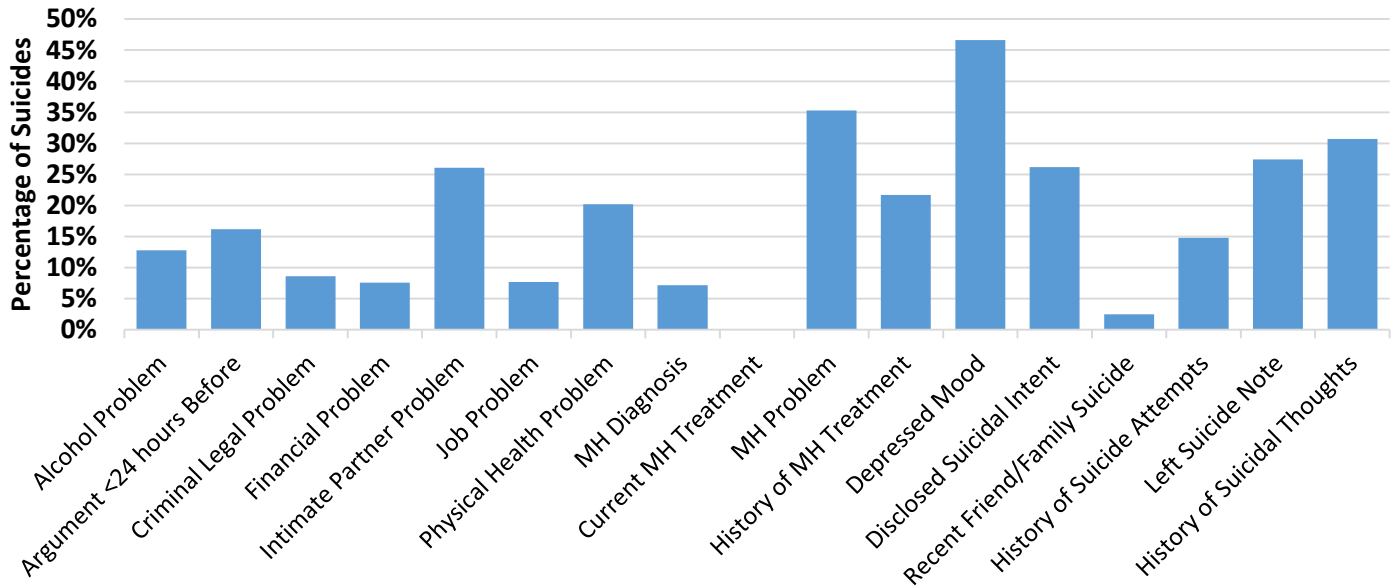


**Education Level of Suicide Decedents**

Of those with Mental Health Diagnoses, 55 were diagnosed with depression, 5 with bipolar disorder, and 2 with schizophrenia. A decedent could be diagnosed with multiple disorders.

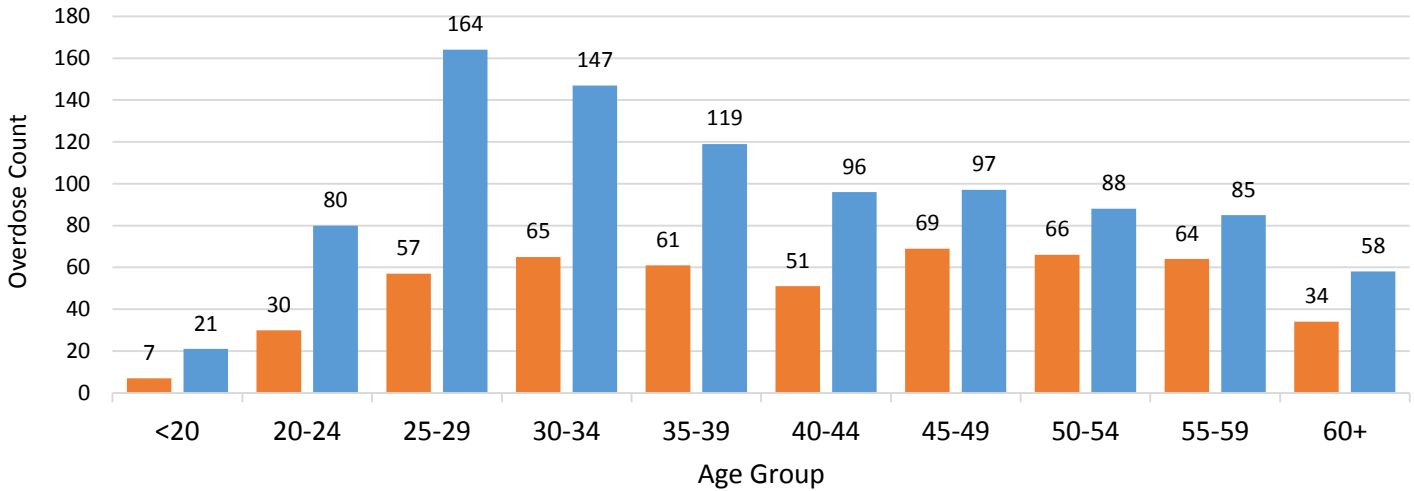

A total of **1,459** unintentional drug overdose deaths occurred in Indiana in 2016. The data below is based off those deaths.

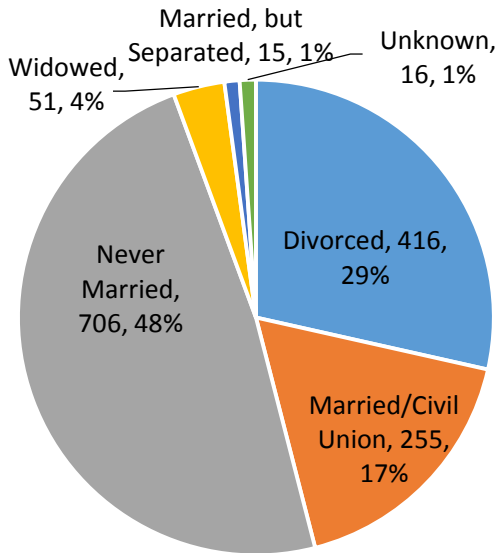
## Overdoses by Age and Sex

Female Male

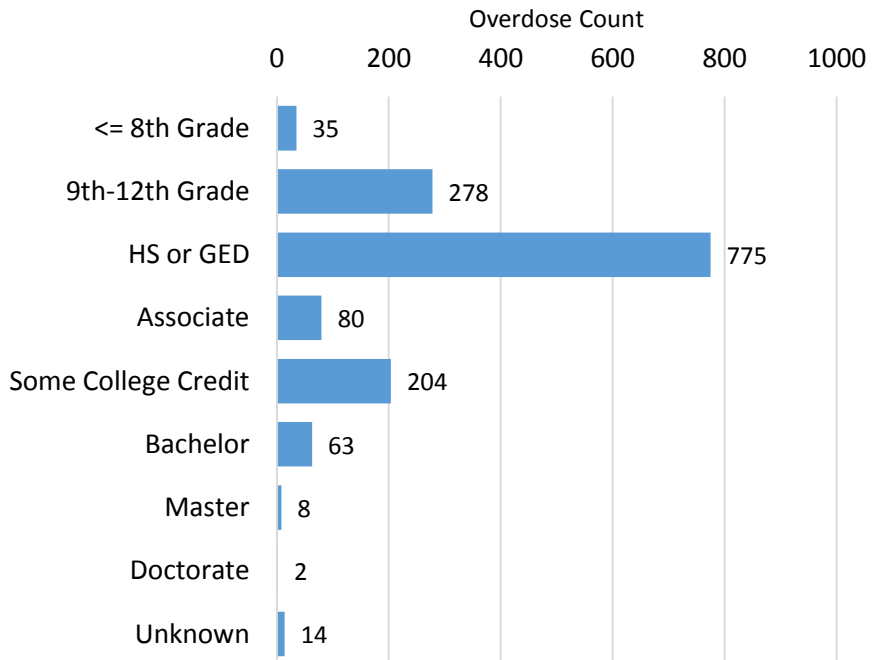


## Marital Status

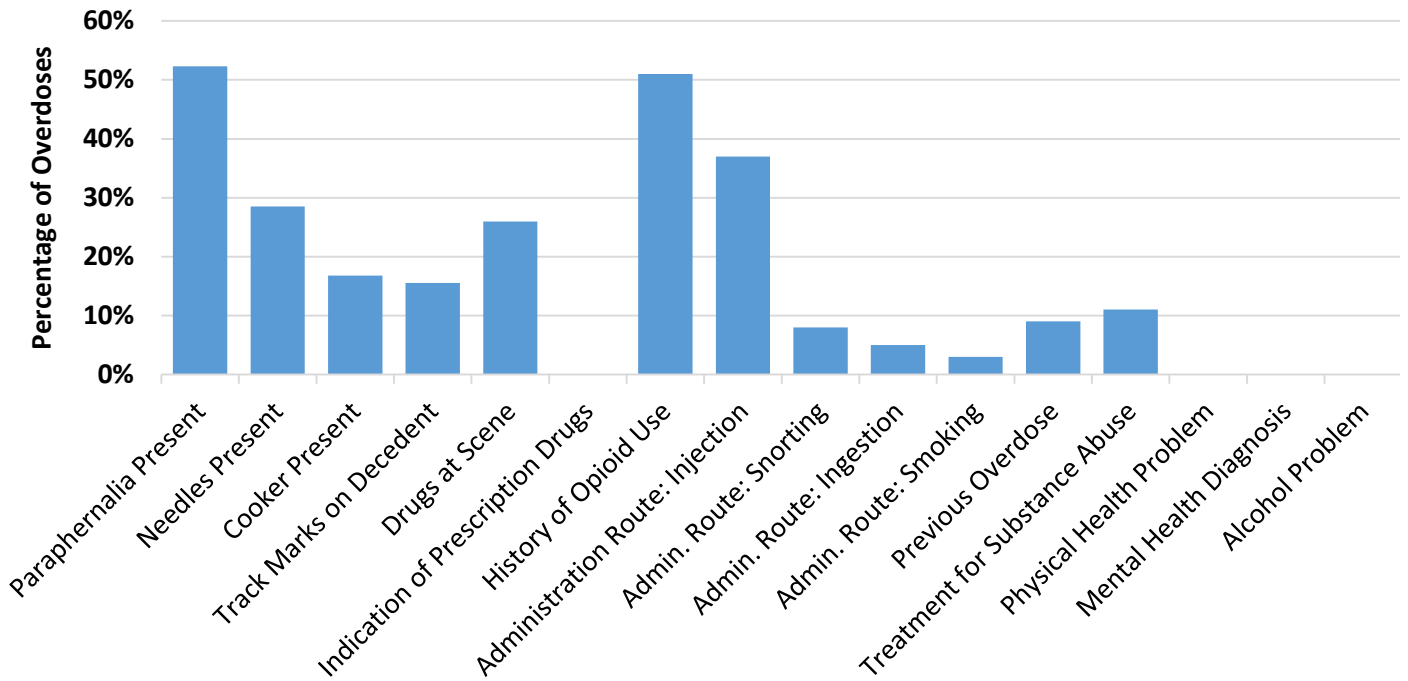


## Education Level of Overdose Decedents

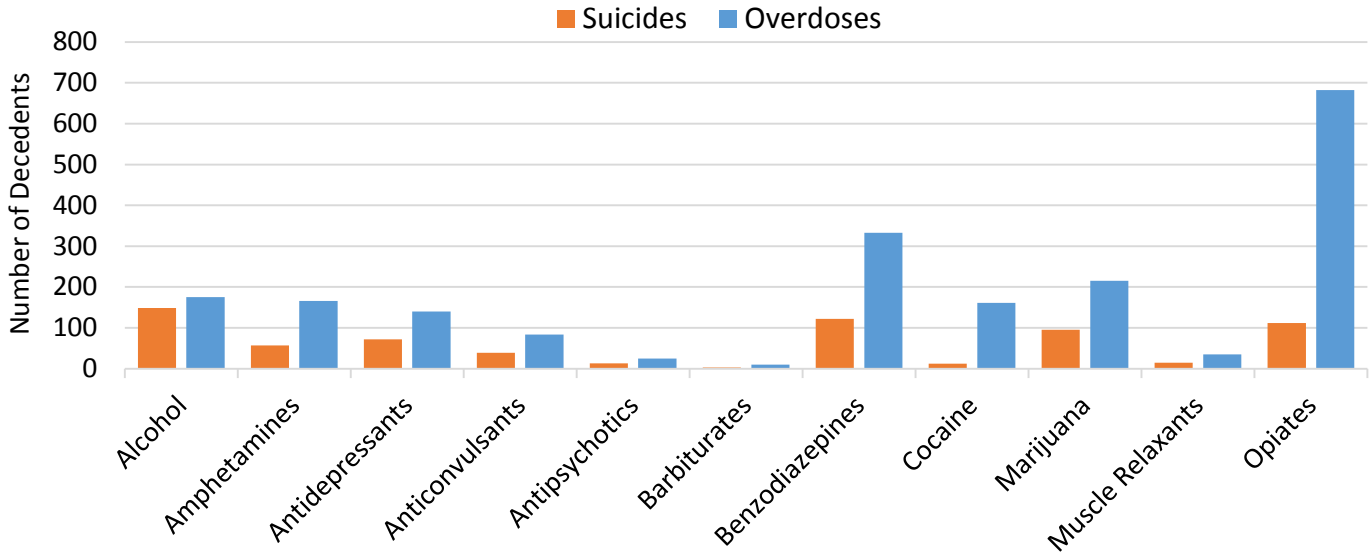

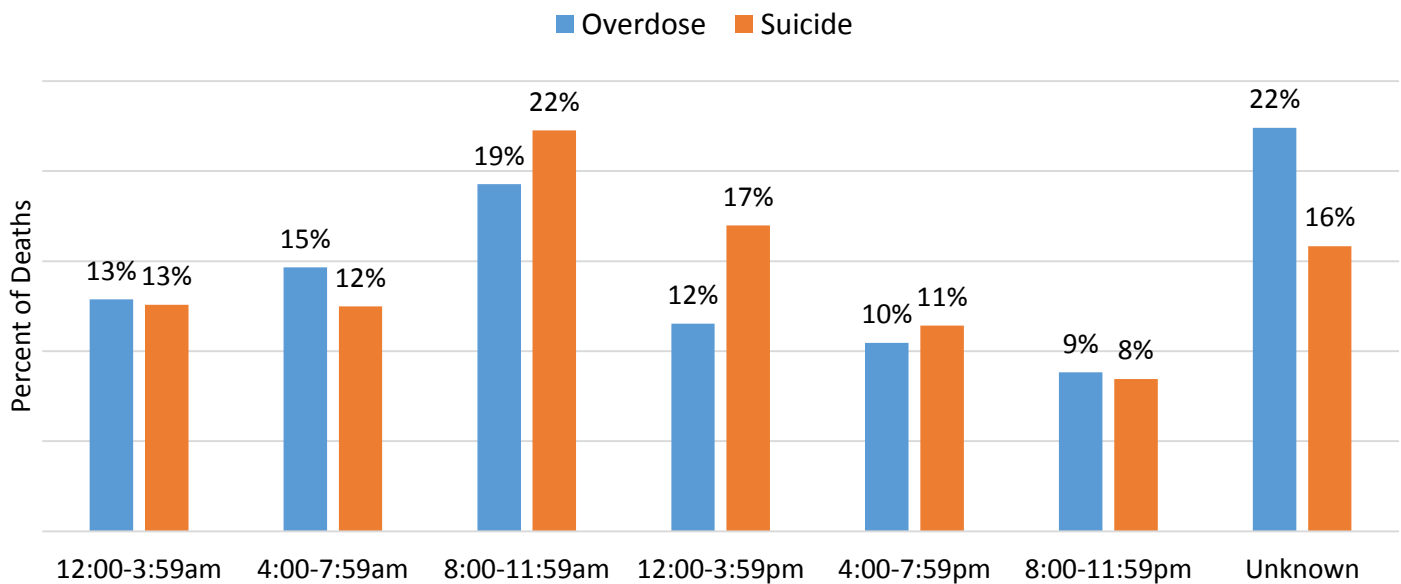
# Substances Present in Suicide and Unintentional Drug Overdose Decedents
