Dear Ms. Fritz,

Pursuant to IC 4-22, the Indiana Office of Small Business and Entrepreneurship ("OSBE") has reviewed the economic impact analysis for small business associated with rule changes contained in LSA Document 15-386 proposed by the Indiana State Department of Health ("ISDH"). The proposed rule adds 410 IAC 15-1.1-18.5 to include the definition of "Qualified Dietitian," and amends 410 IAC 15-1.5-1 to comply with the conditions of participation in food and dietetic services as required by HEA 1157 and 42 CFR 482.28. It amends 410 IAC 17-9-20 by updating the definition of "Medication Assistance" to comply with SEA 358. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.

The economic impact statement prepared by ISDH states there will no be economic impact on small businesses. OSBE does not object to the economic impact to small business associated with the proposed rule.
