**SUBJECT:** Emergency Adoption of Radon Rule

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) Lead and Healthy Homes program requests the Executive Board, at the Board's July 8, 2020 meeting, to emergency adopt an amendment to the radon rule (410 IAC 5.1). The emergency rule shall be effective July 8, 2020.

The proposed emergency rule amendment revises the certification and standards requirements with regard to radon testing, radon mitigation, and laboratory analysis in accordance with the requirements of House Enrolled Act (HEA) 1334 from the 2020 Legislative Session. In addition, the proposed emergency rule amendment revises and updates the rule's definitions and exclusions. HEA 1334 requires that ISDH adopt an emergency rule to amend these provisions.
