

All of the cool kids aren't doing it!

61% ARE NOT currently sexually active, meaning they have not had sexual intercourse within the past month.



The percentage of students who had sexual intercourse with four or more people during their life has increased from 13% in 2007 to 17% in 2011. **Male: 18%** **Female: 15%**




WHAT YOU CAN DO

Choose abstinence by refraining from any kind of sexual activity.

Talk to your parents or doctor about ways to prevent unwanted pregnancies and getting STIs.

The Indiana YRBS is part of a nationwide surveying effort led by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to monitor students' health risks and behaviors in six categories. The YRBS is conducted every two years among a representative group of Indiana students in grades 9-12.



Are putting themselves at risk for pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections (STIs), by not using a condom.

Are you?

39% of males DID NOT use a condom. 45% of females DID NOT use a condom.

Condoms can prevent pregnancy and most sexually transmitted infections if used correctly and consistently each time you have sexual intercourse. Abstinence is the only 100% guaranteed way to prevent both pregnancy and STIs.
