# Division Director Appointment

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) is pleased to announce the selection of Courtney Hamilton, RN, as the Director for the Division of Healthcare Education and Quality. The Division is one of five divisions in the Healthcare Quality and Regulatory Commission with primary responsibilities as part of the health care facility licensing and certification survey program. Among other responsibilities, the Division coordinates training of state surveyors, coordinates the survey data, and administers the aide registry. The Director is also a significant contributor to healthcare quality improvement projects and initiatives.

Courtney graduated in 2001 from the University of Cincinnati with a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice. In 2009 she received a Master's Degree in Nursing from Xavier University. Courtney is currently enrolled at IUPUI in the Masters of Public Health Program in Health Policy and Management.

## Recalls

#### February 28, 2012

Flight Medical V24-00400-29 Cable for Newport HT50 Ventilator: Class I Recall - Cable May Cause an Electrical Shortage That can Cause Ventilators to Shutdown Unexpectedly

ISSUE: The recalled cable may cause an electrical shortage that can cause Newport HT50 ventilators manufactured prior to 2007 to shutdown unexpectedly.

BACKGROUND: The V24-00400-20 cable is an accessory intended to transfer the alarm signal from a Newport HT50 ventilator to a nurse station. The affected cables were distributed between April 25, 2007 and July 6, 2011. A total of 328 cables were distributed within the US.

RECOMMENDATIONS: On August 23, 2011, Flight Medical sent an urgent Recall Notice to affected customers through its distributor, Newport Medical. Affected customers were advised to take the following actions:

- Stop using the alarm cable immediately
- Contact Newport Medical in order to receive an upgraded version of the cable free of charge.
- Customer inquiries related to this action should be addressed to Newport Medical's Technical Service Group at 1-800-451-3111, extension 500.
- Affected cables should be disposed of according to local municipal guidelines.
