Developmental Calendar Update

English Version

St. Vincent has partnered with distribution and paying for the production on 12,000 calendars that will be given to families in their hospitals, obstetrician offices and special events. Riley Hospital distribution is in the works.

Spanish Version

Eloquence language has been working on converting the document. Graphics are now being decided upon. Due to the difference in language, the calendar with current graphics is 10 – 15% longer than the English version. The artist is helping with graphics to reduce that so the calendars will be the same size.

Financial Fact Sheets

The group reviewed individual sheets as a committee. Recommended changes were noted by Toni Harpster and Mary Jo Paladino.
