RE: Final Adoption of Newborn Screening rule amendments, LSA # 18-158 (410 IAC 3-3)

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) requests the Executive Board, at the Board's September 12, 2018 meeting, finally adopt the rule that amends the newborn screening rule 410 IAC 3-3 to update the list of conditions screened for, to change the time period for specimen collection, to add requirements for newborn pulse oximetry measurement and to update the newborn screening fee.

The Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule was published in the Indiana Register on March 28, 2018, starting the one year period to adopt this rule. A draft version of the rule was presented to the Executive Board for its review on November 8, 2017. The Executive Board finally adopted the rule at the July 11, 2018 Executive Board meeting, but there was a technical problem with the rulemaking requiring the Executive Board to adopt it again. Changes were made between the Proposed Rule published in the Indiana Register on May 9, 2018 and the final rule; however, no changes have been made since the previous adoption.
