


Pregnancy and Natality Report

Both the number of pregnancies and terminated pregnancies are indicators of HIV risk factors (e.g. sexual behavior). Reported pregnancies include live births, fetal deaths and induced terminated pregnancies that occurred in Indiana to Indiana residents. In 2004, the latest data available for this report, the overall pregnancy rate was 75.1 per 1,000 females aged 15-49 in Indiana¹. In absolute terms there were 82,664 pregnancies down from 97,818 in 2003.


Figure 66: Pregnancy Rates by Age Category, 2004

As shown in Figure 66, women aged 25 to 29 years had the highest pregnancy rate (137.4 per 1000 females) and women aged 45 to 49 years had the lowest (0.4 per 1000 females).

It is interesting to note that the share of pregnancies among White mothers age 24 and under is higher than for African American mothers. They increase their share of pregnancies in the age groups of 25 and older.
