Percent of adults who smoke: **18%**

- **Indiana: 21.8%**
- **United States: 17.1%**

Cardiovascular deaths: **299.8**

(per 100,000 residents)

- **Indiana: 243.9**
- **United States: 222.3**

Lung cancer deaths: **67.7**

(per 100,000 residents)

- **Indiana: 50.7**
- **United States: 41.8**

Asthma related emergency room visits: **35.9**

(per 10,000 residents)
