* In 2020, the cases analyzed include 8,121 cases that were tested and 3,165 cases administratively withdrawn. An additional 2,553 cases were completed by outsourcing to a contracted accredited laboratory.

* In 2021, the cases analyzed include 10,678 cases that were tested and 3,889 cases administratively withdrawn. An additional 2,256 were completed by outsourcing to a contracted accredited laboratory.

* In 2022, the cases analyzed include 9,914 cases that were tested and 4,762 cases administratively withdrawn. An additional 1,033 were completed by outsourcing to a contracted accredited laboratory.

* In 2023, the cases analyzed include 11,006 cases that were tested and 7,010 cases administratively withdrawn. An additional 608 were completed by outsourcing to a contracted accredited laboratory.

* In 2024, the cases analyzed include 11,565 cases that were tested and 4,651 cases administratively withdrawn. An additional 6,709 were completed by outsourcing to a contracted accredited laboratory.

* In 2025, the cases analyzed include 11,479 cases that were tested and 2,454 cases administratively withdrawn.
