Opportunity for Public Comment on Lafayette Municipal Water Works' Rate Case

- WHAT:** A field hearing will be held in Lafayette by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) to hear from the public on the rate case petition of Lafayette Municipal Water Works under [Cause No. 45006](#).
- WHEN:** February 7, 2018, at 6 p.m. ET
- WHERE:** Jefferson High School – Rohrman Performing Arts Center, 1801 South 18th Street, Lafayette, IN 47905
- WHY:** Lafayette Municipal Water Works has filed a petition before the Commission for a new schedule of rates and charges for water utility service.
- HOW:** During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the commissioners and judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case.
