Opportunity for Public Comment on Richmond Power & Light's Rate Case

****Please note operational changes due to COVID-19 below****

- WHAT:** A field hearing will be held in Richmond by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) to hear from the public on the rate case petition of the Richmond Power & Light under [Cause No. 45361](#).
- WHEN:** June 29, 2020, at 6 p.m. ET
- WHERE:** Richmond Municipal Building – Chambers Room, 50 N. 5th Street, Richmond, IN 47374
- WHY:** Richmond Power & Light has filed a petition before the Commission for a new schedule of rates and charges for electric utility service.
- HOW:** During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the commissioners and judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case. COVID-19 EXPECTATIONS: Please note that written comments sent to the OUCC carry the same

weight in the evidence of the case as those spoken at field hearings. Customers who plan to attend this field hearing must enter only at the west entrance of the building through the police department to have their temperature checked, and must then follow signage for enter and exit flow through the room. Customers will be called up to speak in the order they arrive, and we ask that customers avoid congregating in groups before and after the hearing. We recommend all attendees wear masks and observe appropriate social distancing in accordance with CDC guidelines. Hand sanitizer will be available to attendees.
