### **Opportunity for Public Comment on CenterPoint Energy Indiana South's Infrastructure Improvement Case**

- WHAT:** The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) will hold a field hearing in Evansville to hear from the public on the infrastructure improvement petition of Southern Indiana Gas & Electric Company (d/b/a CenterPoint Energy Indiana South) under [Cause No. 45894](#).
- WHEN:** Sept. 13, 2023, at 6 p.m. local time
- WHERE:** Old National Events Plaza (Locust Rooms), 715 Locust Street, Evansville, IN 47708
- WHY:** CenterPoint Energy Indiana South has filed a petition before the Commission for approval of its TDSIC plan for eligible transmission, distribution and storage system improvements.
- HOW:** During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the Commissioners and Judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case.
