Opportunity for Public Comment on Crawfordsville Electric Light & Power's Rate Case

****Please note operational changes due to COVID-19 below****

- WHAT:** A field hearing will be held in Crawfordsville by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) to hear from the public on the rate case petition of Crawfordsville Electric Light & Power under [Cause No. 45420](#).
- WHEN:** October 29, 2020, at 6 p.m. local time
- WHERE:** Fusion 54 – 3rd Floor Conference Room, 101 W. Main St. Crawfordsville, IN 47933
- WHY:** Crawfordsville Electric Light & Power has filed a petition before the Commission for a new schedule of rates and charges for electric utility service.
- HOW:** During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the commissioners and judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case. COVID-19 EXPECTATIONS: Please note that written comments sent to the OUCG carry the same weight in the evidence of the case as those spoken at field hearings. Customers who plan to attend this field hearing must enter only at the main building entrance and must then follow signage for enter and exit flow through the room. Customers will be called up to speak in the order they arrive, and we ask that customers avoid congregating in groups before and after the hearing.
