Notice is hereby given that Southern Monroe Water Corporation did on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010 file two separate Applications, under and pursuant to the Public Service Commission Act, as amended, with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission seeking increases to the water rates charged to customers of Southern Monroe Water Corporation.

The first Application commonly referred to as the wholesale water cost tracker is described in paragraph (1) below, and the second application which is a request for an increase independent of the wholesale water cost tracker is described in paragraph (2) below.

(1) Southern Monroe Water Corporation has filed with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission for an increase in its Schedule of Rates and Charges for water sold by Southern Monroe Water Corporation in the amount of \$1.09 per 1,000 gallons pursuant to the wholesale water cost tracker as a result of the increase which the City of Bloomington Utilities has requested for the cost of wholesale water. 


