

Winter Reliability and Preparedness

Assets

- Peak day system design minus 17° F
- Four interstate pipelines
- Looped transmission system
- On-system storage and peaking





Coordination Activities

- Active communications with key stakeholders
 - Natural gas suppliers
 - Third-party marketers
 - Power generation customers
 - Interstate Pipelines

Highlighted 2023 Activity

Assets

- Installed seven traps for line cleaning and inspection of storage transmission lines
- Electro-magnetic casing inspection on 14 production wells
- Installed eight transmission system remote valves
- Conducted four integrity digs
- Added six natural gas suppliers

Power Generation Support


• Citizens supports approximately 1,500 MW of power generation by distributing natural gas to three facilities:

Facility	Firm Transportation		Interruptible Transportation	
	Daily	Hourly	Daily	Hourly
Facility A	70%	83%	30%	17%
Facility B	83%	100%	17%	0%
Facility C*	0%	0%	100%	100%

Note: Based on historical peak demands observed by Citizens



Natural Gas - Hourly Demands by Class





- Leaves excess services unutilized


 Balanced portfolio with services like storage, peaking, and no notice to balance changing demands






Supply Planning & Winter Price Projections


