Fortville Municipal Water Utility 30-Day Filing

Dear Ms. Howe:

Pursuant to 170 IAC 1-6, enclosed is the following 30 Day filing by the Fortville Municipal Water Utility. Five copies of the Supplementary Calculation worksheet have been enclosed. The purpose of this filing is to establish a fire protection (hydrant) fee for water users located outside of the Town's corporate limits who do not contribute to the Town's property tax base. Since the Town subsidizes the fire protection related water system capacity costs through its local property tax levy, any customer that is not located inside of the Town is not contributing their fair share towards these fire protection system capacity costs. It is presumed that the Town will continue to subsidize its residents for the hydrants located *inside* the corporate limits. Should that change in the future, the Town will ensure parity between inside and outside customers with respect to hydrant charges. The charge is proposed to become effective on July 1, 2015.

This proposed change is to recoup the costs of service, including water system fire flow capacity costs, as well as maintenance and other expenses incurred for hydrants, high service pumps and overhead storage facilities that are owned and operated by the Fortville Municipal Water Utility. In the past, the number of outside users were relatively nominal. Most all of the Town's water customers were located within the corporate limits (or were anticipated to be annexed) at which point fire protection costs are covered by property tax revenues. However, due to new subdivision developments in an adjacent County, establishing hydrant surcharges for out of Town users is essential to ensure that all users are treated fairly and pay the same costs that the inside Town users pay, albeit through property taxes. 170 IAC 1-6 addresses this specific situation and the Town respectfully submits this 30 day filing consistent therewith. There are no other adjustments to rates or other charges contemplated as part of this filing.

The Town also has published notice of its intention to make the 30-Day Filing in at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation in Fortville, Indiana. Town of Fortville, Indiana - Municipal Water Utility Notice of Filing with Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission for Tariff Amendments - Recurring Charges

Pursuant to the procedures outlined in 170 IAC 1-6-6, the Town of Fortville is filing amendments to Schedule of "Public Fire Protection" charges of its existing Water Utility Tariff Sheet with the INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION (IURC).

- (A) The nature of the filing: Amends recurring charges for hydrant fees for customers located outside the corporate limit who do not contribute to the Town's property tax base. The proposed charge has been calculated at \$8.85 per month for affected users, and is based on the actual cost per hydrant, per annum that is currently being paid by all of the customers located inside of the Town's corporate limits through the Town's property tax levies.
- (B) Which customers may be affected: Customers located outside of the corporate limits who are served by the Town's water utility and subject to the utility's Water Tariff / Fees.
- (C) How those customers may be affected: The impact on the customer's monthly water bill has been calculated at \$8.85 per month, based upon the number of in-town hydrants divided by the number of in-town customers.
- (D) A new subdivision development in an adjacent County is driving the need for the 30 day filing at this time so that the Town can begin implementing the Hydrant Charges in July, 2015. New customers are anticipated to begin receiving service in the new development outside of Hancock County on or about that time. While the adjacent County development is driving this filing, the implementation will affect a handful of existing customers located outside of the Town, in Vernon Township, Hancock County.

The Town filed its Tariff Revisions with the IURC on January 30, 2015. However, the 30-day filing clock will not start until after proof of publication of this Notice is filed with the IURC. The expected filing completion date is anticipated to be completed on or around February 25th, 2015.

The date by which approval of the filing is expected from the IURC is sometime during April, 2015. The Town is proposing an effective date of July 1, 2015.

This tariff Amendment <u>will not</u> affect customers located within the Town's Corporate Limits, as the Town Council intends to continue to subsidize the in-town customers through property taxes.
