Opportunity for Public Comment on Anderson Municipal Light & Power's Rates and Financing Case

WHAT: The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) will hold a field hearing in Anderson to hear from the public on the electric rates and financing petition of Anderson Municipal Light & Power under [Cause No. 46397](#).

WHEN: Monday, July 20, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. (local time)

WHERE: Anderson City Hall Auditorium
120 East Eighth Street, Anderson, IN 46016

WHY: Anderson Municipal Light & Power filed a petition before the Commission requesting approval to increase its rates and charges for electric service and approval of financing for system improvements.

HOW: During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the Commissioners and Judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case.
