# GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 1991-3 OF THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission is a public agency of the State of Indiana charged by statute with the regulation and supervision of utility rates in Indiana, and

WHEREAS, the Commission is authorized by I.C. 8-1-2-42(g) to permit changes in a gas utility's rates, tolls, and charges based upon changes in the utility's cost of gas, and has implemented gas cost adjustment procedures through its Order in Cause No. 37091, and

WHEREAS, the Commission believes it should be more knowledgeable, and the public should be fully informed about the effects the proposed gas cost adjustment factor will have upon the reasonable cost of the utility service, and

WHEREAS, the Commission believes that comparing the proposed gas cost factor with both the factor in effect during a period of comparable weather in the previous year as well as with the current factor will promote better public understanding,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission, in order to fulfill its lawful obligations, and in order to serve the public interest, hereby adopts the Filing Procedures and Guidelines for the Gas Cost Adjustment Bill Comparisons, attached hereto as Appendix A, made a part hereof and incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this General Administrative Order is effective immediately.

#### APPENDIX A

Filing Procedures and Guidelines for the Gas Cost Adjustment (GCA) Bill Comparisons.

Every gas utility that files a petition for a change in its Gas Cost Adjustment as prescribed by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission pursuant to I.C. 8-1-2-42(g), shall file with such petition a table comparing the bill effects on its residential space-heating customers of:

- Its requested GCA factor versus its currently approved factor and,
- 2) Its requested GCA factor versus the GCA factor approved for the same period one year prior.

Additionally, any revisions by the utility filed subsequent to the original filing, reflecting a change to the proposed GCA factor applicable to space-heating customers, shall also include the bill comparisons. The utility shall also indicate on the bill comparisons if base rates have changed between the effective period of the "proposed" and "current" or "prior year" GCA factor.

The Office of the Utility Consumer Counselor (OUCC) shall also submit bill comparisons when it proposes a different GCA factor for the residential space-heating gas customers than the utility.

Bill comparison tables should take the form set forth on page 2.
