

The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC or Commission) is holding an Investigative Inquiry on Energy Affordability concerning the five largest electric investor-owned utilities, who will present and answer questions from the Commission and the Indiana Office of Consumer Counselor on topics related to energy affordability, including how usage and rates lead to bills, the impact of growth on affordability, and steps that can be taken in the short term to increase bill transparency and address rising energy costs.
