IURC Approves SNG Contract
Cause No. 43976

Today the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) approved the substitute natural gas (SNG) contract between the Indiana Finance Authority (Authority) and Indiana Gasification, LLC (IG). Specifically, the IURC granted the following:

- Approval of the 30-year SNG contract
- Issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to IG for the construction of the SNG facility

Further, the Authority and IG have been ordered to file information, including an annual report, with the IURC in order to meet reporting requirements.
