The Indiana Underground Plant Protection Advisory Committee (“Committee”) will meet on Tuesday, October 20, 2020. Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb issued Back on Track Indiana guidelines at www.BackOnTrack.in.gov. These guidelines are related to the COVID-19 pandemic and encourage allowing people to work from home and limit travel, where possible, during this time of public health emergency.
