Wabash Valley Power respectfully requests a one year extension to submit our 2020 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) to the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission.

Wabash Valley Power is exploring several complex issues which will prevent us from having a complete and comprehensive submission November 1, 2020 due date. Additionally, Wabash Valley Power is in process of engaging consultants to assist with developing our capacity plan alternatives and to provide guidance surrounding our scenario modeling. Given the dramatically and quickly changing supply landscape, Wabash Valley Power needs additional time to produce a plan that is both valid and reasonable, and meets the needs as set for by the Commission.

Furthermore, we would appreciate additional time to determine whether and/or how we need to adjust our load forecast for the impacts of COVID-19. Given that Wabash Valley Power serves load in three states, we have the added complexity of not only monitoring COVID-19 and the resulting economic situation in Indiana, but also in Illinois and Missouri.

Wabash Valley Power intends to produce an IRP that meets the Commission's and our Stakeholders' needs, but also minimizes costs and risks to our Members.
