This filing also updates intrastate switched access rates to comply with FCC requirements for compensation on intrastate 8YY (toll-free) calls

Tariff Page(s) Affected: Clear Rate Communications, LLC: IURC Tariff No. 1

Staff Recommendations: Requirements in 170 IAC 1-6 and Cause Nos. 44004 and 45733 were met. Staff believes relevant FCC requirements were also met. Notwithstanding IC 8-1-32.5-11(c), the IURC must still review intrastate access charges for reasonableness.² **Staff believes Clear Rate Communications, LLC’s I.U.R.C. Tariff No. 2 is reasonable, as amended on January 27, 2023, and recommends approval of amended 30-day filing # 50591.**
