Customer Impact: The purpose of this filing is to revise the Normal Temperature Adjustment to include Leap Year Normal Temp Adjustment Normal Degree Days in the tariff. In IUC’s recent rate case in Cause No. 46086, the leap year data was not available; therefore, only non-leap year data was presented and approved in the final tariff. Since such information is now available and after discussions with the Office of Utility Consumer Counselor, IUC is updating this information to be included in its tariff. There is no customer impact until 2028, the next leap year.
