<b>Request:</b>	Change in the rate for I&M's Discretionary Load Management Service (DLMS) Rider.
<b>Customer Impact:</b>	Rider DLMS is a voluntary offer that was first approved via 30-Day filing No. 50569 on June 13, 2022. It is available to customers that take firm service from I&M under a demand metered rate schedule and that have the ability to curtail load under the provisions of this Rider. The credit amount is calculated using the average for current and the previous 9 years of PJM Base Residual Auction results as well as the AEP Zonal Network Integration Transmission Service Expenses. The credit amount is being updated from the current \$5.00/kW-month to \$4.70/kW-month for customers participating in the Rider.
<b>Tariff Pages Affected:</b>	IURC No. 20, Original Sheet No. 35.5.
<b>Staff Recommendation:</b>	The calculation of the credit is consistent with the methodology used when this Rider was initially approved. Filing requirements have been met. Recommend approval.
