**Request:** NIPSCO is proposing revisions to its Electric Service Tariff Rate 624 – Rate for Electric Service - General Service – Large and Rule 1 Definitions, Original Volume No. 16. An agreement between NIPSCO and a customer for service was filed seeking Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approval under Ind. Code §§ 8-1-2-24 and 8-1-2-25 (the “Customer-Specific Contract”). NIPSCO anticipates approval of the Customer-Specific Contract will occur after the date the customer has requested service (summer of 2026) and intends to utilize Rate 624 to provide electric service until the time the Customer-Specific Contract is approved.
