**Request:** DEI is requesting an update to Tariff 46 – Rate MS – Metered Signal Service, which applies to metered traffic or flasher signal systems belonging to municipalities, the State of Indiana, or other agencies legally authorized to own and operate traffic or flasher signal systems. The tariff update shows that traffic or flasher signal customers, who do not have meters, will be charged the per kWh charge on Tariff 46.

**Customer Impact:** DEI is not proposing to change the existing Tariff No. 46 rates in this filing. Accordingly, the table below details the current charges applied under Tariff No. 46 for informational purposes only.

<b>Primary Connection Charge per Meter</b>	\$62.82/month
<b>Secondary Connection Charge per Meter</b>	\$18.00/month
<b>All kWh</b>	\$0.111912/kWh
