**Request:** Monon Telephone Company ("Monon") updated itsIndiana intrastate access tariff on July 1, 2021, with a requested effective date of July 1<sup>2</sup>, as required by the FCC's "8YY Order" andrelated administrative rules regarding intercarrier compensation on toll-free calls.<sup>3</sup>

Monon concurs with the Rochester Telephone Company intrastate access tariff (I.U.R.C. No. 1), except for rates and charges for End User Access Service and 800 Data Base Access Service.

Pursuant to IC 8-1-32.5-11(e), all communications tariffs filed afterJune 30, 2021, become effective upon filing. Therefore, the exceptions for Monon's intrastate End User Access Service and its 800 Data Base Access Service (filed on July 1) went into effect on July 1. It is important to note, however, the Commission is still required to review all intrastate access changes for reasonableness, pursuant to IC 8-1-2-88.6(b). This write-up includes the results of Staff's review of the July 1 exceptions.

**Retail Customer Impact:** The End User Charge is an existing charge. The dollar amount of the

charge is not being modified, so there is no new impact on retail customers. The data base access charge is is a form of intercarrier compensation that other carriers would pay Monon to perform a database query on their behalf. This charge is not assessed on retailend user

customers.

**Tariff Page(s) Affected:** Monon Telephone Company, Tariff I.U.R.C. No. T-8, Section VI,

Sheets 5, 6, & 8.

**Staff Recommendations:** Requirements in IC 8-1-32.5-11(c), 170 IAC 1-6, and IURC CauseNo.

44004 were met. Staff believes that applicable FCC requirements were also met. Staff has reviewed the intrastate exceptions and changes to Monon's I.U.R.C. T-8 tariff described herein and recommends final

approval.
