requirements for intercarrier compensation on toll-free ("8YY") calls - subject to the exceptions identified within the instant tariff filing.

Staff believes the proposed changes

are reasonable and recommends final approval.

¹ Note, this tariff is the Craigville CLEC intrastate access tariff. AdamsWells' CTA is statewide, except for the Craigville Telephone Company, Inc. ILEC service territory. Customers seeking to purchase intrastate access services in Craigville's ILEC territory will need to purchase those services separately. The Craigville ILEC is currently listed as a concurring carrier in the intrastate access tariff of Rochester Telephone Company ("Rochester"). Title Sheet 1 of the instant tariff explains the respective territories of the Craigville ILEC and CLEC entities, and includes a citation to the Rochester tariff.
