Request: NIPSCO submits language modifications for its Rider 373 –

Universal Service Program ("USP") Rider in this thirty-day filing. The modification revises terms applicable to its Hardship Customers to remove the limitation of receiving a one-time grant during a LIHEAP heating season. The revision will allow those customers the opportunity to receive additional grants during the LIHEAP heating

season.

Customer Impact: This revision will not affect any rates or charges for any customer

taking gas service under the USP Rider.
