Request: Duke Energy Indiana ("Duke") is seeking Commission authorization

to update Rate LLF Optional Time of Use Service.

Rate LLF Optional Time of Use Service is currently available to customers whose electric service is provided under Rate LLF and whose average Billing Maximum Load over the last twelve months is greater than or equal to 1,000 KW. Duke is proposing to remove the 1,000 KW minimum load requirement so that more customers would be eligible for this rate. This rate is attractive for customers whose load occurs predominantly during off-peak hours. By eliminating the 1,000 KW minimum load requirement, all LLF customers, including small customers, would be eligible to use this Time of Use rate.

Customer Impact: No customer rate impact is expected, as this filing only affects the

customer eligibility and terms of service.

Tariff Pages Affected: IURC No. 15, First Revised Sheet No. 10.4, Pages 1 through 3 of 3.

Staff Recommendations: Requirements met. Recommend approval.
