Request: I&M requests approval of amendments to its streetlighting tariff for the City of Fort Wayne, Tariff FW-SL (Fort Wayne Streetlighting – Customer Owned and Maintained System). The proposed modifications will provide that kWh’s used by lamps rated at differing values shall be determined and added to the list as appropriate. This proposal is the result of discussions between I&M and the City of Fort Wayne and are being submitted under mutual agreement.

Customer Impact: The customer impact varies based on the determinants of the kWh calculations for each of the various lighting options.

Tariff Pages Affected: First Revised Sheet Nos. 29.1, 29.2, 29.3, 29.4, 29.5, 29.6, and 29.7

Staff Recommendations: Requirements met. Staff recommends approval.
