Request: The utility proposes to remove language and charges as reflected in its existing tariff for Rates and Charges on Pages 3 & 4 and for Water Works Rules on Page 11:

- Section e - removes language related to installment payments of tap fees.
- Section h – eliminates language and the charge related to changing billing information.
- Section j - eliminates language implying a customer could offer payment of any outstanding water balance to the Company's serviceman when he or she arrives at a customer's premises to disconnect water service.
- Paragraph XI G – eliminates paragraph XI G, the charge related to changing billing information.

Customer Impact: Tap fees cannot be paid with installment payments. A fee will not be charged when billing information is updated.

Tariff Pages Affected: Pages 3 and 4 of Rates and Charges. Page 6 of Water Works Rules
