

Evergreen Indiana FAQ

Jasper County Public Library will become a member of Evergreen Indiana on August 12, 2026.

1) What is Evergreen Indiana?

Evergreen is a growing consortium of public, school & institutional libraries and library systems throughout Indiana. This resource sharing initiative provides cost savings for the library and access to 8 million items.

2) Will I need a new card?

No. The first time you visit a JCPL location after August 12, staff will double check all your information and provide you with an Evergreen sticker to add to your library card.

3) What if I have a card from an Evergreen library already?

Your accounts will be merged.

4) Are all Evergreen Indiana libraries fine free?

No. JCPL will remain fine free except for hotspots and lost or damaged items. Items will follow the Fine Policy of the library they are checked out from. If you travel to another Evergreen library that has late fees any items you check out may be eligible for late fees, even if returned to JCPL.

5) Is there an app?

Yes, Evergreen Indiana has an app available for iOS and Android.

What will change:

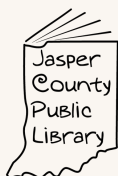
catalog, borrowing times for some materials, automatic renewals will change to 2, patrons under 18 will have a "limited" card type which allows them to check out any movie that isn't R rated

What doesn't change:

access to digital content on Libby, Kanopy, Hoopla and other databases
