

Jasper County Public Library Reciprocal Borrowing Policy

Per the Evergreen Indiana Shared Circulation Policy, “Patrons of Indiana public libraries not participating in the Evergreen Indiana Library Consortium may establish an account at an Evergreen Indiana Member Library pursuant to reciprocal borrower and other agreements. Users from non-participating Indiana libraries may not have the same privileges as Evergreen Indiana resident patrons and such accounts may be suspended at any time without notice.”

If someone resides outside of the JCPL service area and is not a resident of an Evergreen Indiana library system, they must present an active library card in good standing from a library which participates in the Reciprocal Borrowing Program.

Borrowing privileges allow reciprocal borrowers to borrow all materials which are available to residents of the JCPL service area except for electronic resources that are pay-per-use or publisher-restricted, such as Hoopla or Libby from Overdrive. We will *intralibrary* loan (within the JCPL system) for reciprocal borrowers.

PC's: all public access PC's will be available to reciprocal borrowers.

Interlibrary loan (from other libraries not in Evergreen Indiana): Reciprocal borrowers must request items via InShare through their home library.
