Appellate Rule 65(E)

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A certified opinion or memorandum decision is sent by the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Tax Court to the trial court only after the time for all petitions for rehearing or transfer have expired. At that time, the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Tax Court attaches a certification form to the back of the opinion and encloses a certification receipt for signature by the trial court clerk (or a designated employee) and return to the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Tax Court.

Prompt return of the certification receipt to the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Tax Court is **essential** so that the case records are moved from the active case file shelves to Records Department of the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Tax Court for microfilming and archiving.

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
