Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Marilyn A. Moores, Judge of the Marion Superior Court, Juvenile Division, has notified the Court that she will temporarily be unable to perform the duties of her office, effective immediately. We find that in the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of judge of the Marion Superior Court, Juvenile Division. Magistrate Gary K. Chavers has indicated his willingness to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Marion Superior Court, Juvenile Division.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Magistrate Gary K. Chavers is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Marion Superior Court, Juvenile Division, effective the date of this Order, and shall remain as Judge *Pro Tempore* until Judge Moores informs the Court that she can resume the duties of the office and this Court issues a further Order.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Chavers to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Marion Superior Court, Juvenile Division. Judge Chavers shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to T.R. 63(D).
